Kickoff for Canines Campaign Teams

Are you ready to make a difference? Sign up to participate in the <u>Kickoff for Canines Fundraising Campaign</u> to ensure research to help our canine companions live longer, healthier lives continues into the future. Whether you are a business, organization, club, group, or an individual, you can set up a team (or join someone else's team) and raise funds to help future generations of dogs!

What will donations be used for?

Donations support scientific initiatives, like the Dog Aging Project, that will help scientists better understand health and aging in canine companions and provide insight into ways we can improve their healthspan and lifespan. In addition, what we learn from canine studies will also benefit our understanding of human health and aging. A win for everyone!

How do I sign up to participate in the Kickoff for Canines Campaign?

Go to the <u>Kickoff for Canines Fundraising Home Page</u> and set up your own team or join another team.

- Select "start a team"
- Select "create a page" and then create your own team. You may also join another team if
 your company or organization has one set up. People can still credit their donation to
 you if you are a member of a team.
- Select a team name it's a good idea to make your name identifiable to friends and family who will want to give you credit for their donations.
- Set a fundraising goal Aim high! Every dollar counts and helps. The Kickoff will be held
 until the end of the year, but don't want to start since you want to make sure you have
 time to spread the word.
- Add your story about why you support the Dog Aging Institute. You can also add photos
 of yourself, the dog who has inspired you to participate, a company or group logo if you
 are part of of a larger organization, or any image that expresses your reason for
 participating.

How do I let people know I am raising money for the Dog Aging Institute?

- After you set up your fundraising team page and save it, go to your individual team page (make sure your name is in the URL) and select your name under team members. Select the "share fundraiser" button.
- Share your fundraiser with friends, family, colleagues, friends at the dog park, and anyone who cares about dogs!
- Post on social media, and send emails and texts to let everyone know.
- Raise money in celebration of your birthday, in honor or your canine companion, or for any reason, or no other reason than you care about dogs!
